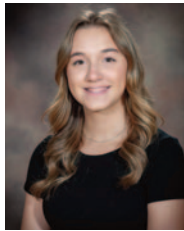

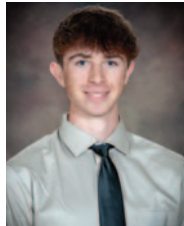

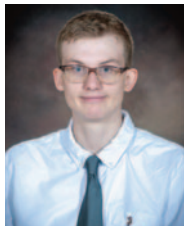

MACST, Inc. History

Mifflinburg Area Community Scholarship Trust, Inc. is a federally recognized 501(c)3 nonprofit organization. Since 2010, **\$643,525** has been awarded to **two hundred eighty-six** different Mifflinburg students attending various post-secondary institutions. Since 2018, sixty-four graduates enrolled in post-secondary institutions were awarded scholarships.

General donations are gladly accepted. These donations and proceeds from the Roy Shifflet Memorial Golf Tournament are divided between scholarship awards for the coming year and investments for long term income for future scholarships.

Donations of \$10,000 or more are invested so the investment income can be used for perpetual scholarships. These \$10,000 donors can set the criteria for Designated Scholarships with the approval of the MACST Board of Directors. To date there are seventeen designated scholarships plus general MACST scholarships. 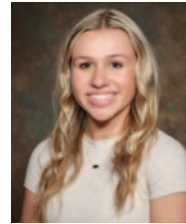
